Letter of Recommendation

In December 2005 has Anchor Contracting assigned to Mostostal Pomorze (MP) a contract to fabricate three Mid Water Arches, all having almost identical design. The structures' main characteristics were as follows:

1. Each composed of a twin buoyancy tank with a large and complex structure made of tubulars supporting riser trays/gutters
2. Each of the buoyancy tanks, six in total, was fabricated and tested as pressure vessel according to PD 5500
3. The entire exterior of the structures was coated by corrosion protection system Norsok No. 7
4. Weight of each structure was about 55 t, external dimensions of about 17 m x 12 m x 10 m

The particular challenges associated with the work were as follows:

1. Time schedule during initiation of the work was disturbed by delayed supply of materials that was outside MP's responsibility.
2. Complexity of the supporting structure.
3. Failure of an external pressure testing component that caused a minor damage of one of the buoyancy tanks requiring a quick repair.


